The Great Falls tennis community had another excellent year in 2012. We hosted the High School Class AA divisional meet. For that tournament, the Riverside Courts and the Meadowlark Country Club Courts (inside and outside) were utilized. The Senior Olympics were held in June at the CMR courts with about 36 participants and there were approximately 20 that qualified to go onto the nationals this summer in Cleveland, Ohio. In July the State Senior Team Tennis tournament was held at CMR courts.
